INTRODUCTION

The call for inclusive education in the light of historical marginalisation of peoples in india, is an issue that concerns educators, policy makers and activist. Many attempts have been made to make education more inclusive. Very innovative ways have also been developed and operationalized by universities, non-government and community led organizations at the systemic levels and by educators at the curriculum and pedagogical levels to work towards realizing inclusion. Exclusion in India is a complex phenomena cutting across caste, gender, ethnicity, age, tribe, language, region, religion, etc, while at the same time having to intersect with the realities produced by affiliations, state responsibility and community participation.

Debates on education in india are currently taking place around issues concerning state policy, laws, acts and government initiatives, plus the role played by international institutions and mechanisms of global political Economy. While arguments and counterarguments are being made on issues such the right to free, fair and inclusive education and equal accessibility to education at the primary. Secondary and higher levels, on the ground, however, educators are confronted with the issues of social discrimination and exclusion, extreme cases of social tension, anachronistic curriculum and incongruous pedagogies.

In the light of this context, the centre for social justice & governance and the national coalition for education are collaborating to organize a one-day national seminar on the theme of ideas, peoples and inclusive education in india today.
